Coal Production in the First Three Months of 2017 Reached 3.291 Million Tonnes

China Resources Power Holdings Company Limited (“CR Power”, stock code: 0836) today announced that total coal production in March 2017 decreased by 1.5% to 1.310 million tonnes from 1.330 million tonnes for the same period last year. Total coal production for the first three months of 2017 increased by 8.8% to 3.291 million tonnes compared to 3.026 million tonnes for the same period last year.
